St. Vitus Lodge #25 share of the proceeds went to support the charity for St. Vitus Catholic War Veterans (CWV) Post 1655. The charity that they chose was WAGS 4 Warriors. This organization's mission is to unite veterans whom upon returning home from war suffer from PTSD or TBI with an appropriate dog and to provide all of the training, equipment, and support for the dog to become the veteran's service dog at no cost to the veteran. The ultimate goal is for the service dog to take away the struggle that the veterans face every day.

Christ the King Lodge #226's share of the proceeds went to support the charities for The Polish Legion of American Veterans (PLAV) Post 31. They chose to split the proceeds between two organizations. The first is the Polonia Foundation of Ohio. The purpose of the Polonia Foundation is to provide assistance to those of Polish descent or those who are members of a Polish organization in advancing their education through scholarships, grants, fellowships, and other educational projects.

THE BISHOP BARAGA EDUCATIONAL CENTER CELEBRATES ITS GRAND OPENING

The Annual Baraga Days was held on Saturday & Sunday, August 18th & 19th in Marquette, Michigan to honor the diocese's first bishop, Venerable Frederic Baraga. A highlight of the event was the grand opening of the Bishop Baraga Educational Center, a project that took years in the making. KSKJ Life participated in the Educational Center's Campaign by sponsoring the Computer Center. KSKJ Life board Member Tony Menart made an appearance at the grand opening to represent the organization.

The Educational Center is located in the historic house that Baraga once lived in. The Bishop Baraga Association hoped to create a resource that will preserve the artifacts used by Bishop Baraga during his ministry and comply with the Norms for Beatification. This center will capture the essence of Baraga: the man, the priest and the Bishop as he ministered throughout the Great Lakes Region. The Bishop Baraga Association plans to add a prayer garden outside the Educational Center in the future.

With cool fall weather quickly approaching, a satisfying bowl of Slovenian Goulash will hit the spot! Connie Menart of Lodge #59 in Eveleth, MN was kind enough to share her delicious recipe for all to enjoy.

SLOVENIAN GOULASH

Ingredients:

- 1 ½ lbs. beef stew meat, cut into bite-sized pieces
- 2 to 3 T. oil
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 tsp. salt
- ½ tsp. pepper or more if desired
- 3 T. garlic powder
- 4-5 Tbsp. Paprika
- 4 to 6 oz. tomato paste
- wATER

Instructions:

Brown stew meat in oil. Add chopped onions and cook until browned. Add remaining ingredients. Add water to cover meat and to keep ingredients from scorching. Simmer for 2 to 3 hours, until meat is fork tender.


